# SI 14.2(a)

Sail numbers will be displayed for at least 3 minutes before the next warning signal of her class.

A long sound signal will be made when the numbers are initially displayed.

Boats whose number is so displayed shall leave the racing area, defined in instruction 10.7 before the new preparatory signal. If she fails to do so, she is liable to be scored DNE without a hearing.

# SI 20.1

If possible, protest shall be filed online within the protest time limit. Protest forms will be available at event web page. The protest time limit is:

- On the water, 60 minutes after the last boat of a class has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- Ashore, 30 minutes after the committee signals no more racing today ashore.

## SI 24.1

From July 25, 2021, there will be a coach/support persons and sailors meeting, 90 minutes before the first warning signal of the day.

The objectives of these meetings are to collect feedback from the coach/support persons and sailors about the event organization, and to initiate viewpoints exchange and to inform the coach/support person and skippers about changes in the sailing instructions and/ or the event organization.

## SI 24.6

While afloat, the VHF Channel 12 will be use as communication channel between the Race Committee and coach/support person.
