EXPECTED MARINE FORECAST

Marine Synopsis - As high pressure moves off to the northeast, mainly fair weather persists for a while longer. Isolated to scattered showers then return later today into Saturday as a weak cold front approaches from the northwest. Wind will increase strong behind the front and remain so for much of the weekend and then through early next week as a complex front develops and approaches from the west. Moderate seas briefly build rough on Saturday.

Today - Winds east-southeasterly 8 to 12 knots, tending southeasterly during the afternoon... Isolated showers with fair visibility become scattered showers with fair to poor visibility towards evening... Seas inside the reef 1 to 2 ft... Outside the reef 2 to 4 ft, increasing during the night... Sunrise: 6:51 am.
