All sailors

We are seeing an increasing number of attempts by sailors to enter events with illegal sail numbers. For clarity, we would refer you to:

- Racing Rules of Sailing: rules 77, 78, 87 and Appendix G
- · Class Rules: Part One Fundamental Rule and Part Two section 4

In essence these confirm:

- · the sail number should correspond to the hull number
- where a sailor charters or borrows a boat, the sail number should correspond to their own sail number. If they do not own a boat the sail number should correspond to the hull number. In each case, the prior approval of the Race Management Team is required.
- only events where the organisers provide the hull and/or sails and after the approval of the International Laser Class Association can single, double or triple digit sail numbers be used

The ILCA is a strict one-design class and we would ask sailors to respect that ethos.
