SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

[NP] denotes a rule which cannot be protested by a competitor

Changes on 19 June, 1100 SI 8 and SI 9

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The event is organized by the Nautical Club of Samos.

2. RULES

The event will be governed by the Windsurfing Slalom Rules.

3. COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the <u>online notice board</u>.
- 3.2 Complementary information will be given on the event messenger group. Contact the secretariat to be added to the group: mikorakas@yahoo.gr
- 3.3 The schedule of heats will be posted on the official notice board no later than 15 minutes before the starting signal for the first heat. This changes WSRR 37.3

4. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted not less than 15 minutes before the scheduled warning signal on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the timing of races, will be posted by 2000 the day before it will take effect.
- 4.2 When oral changes are made on the water, the race committee will display flag L and communicate the changes to the competitors.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole at the venue
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, 1 minute is replaced with 'not less than 15 minutes'.

6. MARKS

Marks 1 and 2 are red inflatable pyramids

Marks 3 and 4 are yellow inflatable pyramids

The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag with RC on the race committee vessel and the course side of an orange inflatable cylinder.

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a yellow flag with RC on the race committee vessel and the course side of a yellow inflatable cylinder.

7. START

7.1 The starting signals will be as follows:

Minutes before starting signal	Visual signal	Sound signal	Means
3	Class flag and heat number	One	Attention signal
2	Red flag; class flag removed	One	Warning signal
1	Yellow flag; red flag removed	One	Preparatory signal
1/2	Yellow flag removed		30 seconds
0	Green flag	One	Starting signal

This changes WSRR 26.1

- 7.2 Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area.
- 7.3 Boards not starting within 1 minute after their starting signal will be scored DNS without hearing.
- 7.4 When at a board's starting signal any part of her hull, is on the course side of the starting line, the race committee will signal in heats 1-4 and final C an individual recall on the finishing line and in finals A and B a general recall on the starting line.


8. TIME LIMITS

Boards not finishing within 3 minutes after the first board sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing. This changes WSRR A4 and A5.

9. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 9.1 Protests may be made orally or delivered online. Protest forms are available here.
- 9.2 Hearings will be held at the venue. The protestor shall make every reasonable effort to bring the protestee to the hearing.
