7. Description Of Incident

1 On approach to the break wall, 46380 - Avet was the starboard boat and clear ahead, had right of way.

36014- Big Apple was on port and passed clear to a stern of 46380 - Avet without changing course.

2 46380 - Avet jibed to port, now the leeward boat, when they changed course, lost their right of way.

now 36014- Big Apple the windward boat, on port and who did not change course, had the right of way due to rule 16

3 46380 - Avet on port and the leeward boat, did not give room to 36014-Big Apple, the windward boat, on port, and who did not change course, it's right of way, did not give room needed to clear

the obstruction as per rule 19

4 36014-Big Apple needed another half a boat length to clear the break wall, an obstruction, had to make a hard turn to port to avoid hitting 46380 - Avet and then hit the

underwater part of the break wall.
