Event Sailing Instructions (ESIs) (to be read in conjunction with RS21 Standard Sailing Instructions (RS21SSIs))

1 – RULES

1.1 See RS21SSI Para 1

4 - SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 When flag AP (Answering Pennant) is displayed ashore, "1 minute" is replaced with "not less than 60 minutes" This changes RS21SSI 4.2

5 - SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 The scheduled time of the Warning Signal for the first race on Friday 19th April will be 1400hrs.

5.3 The RC may broadcast safety and racing information on VHF channel 06.

7 - RACING AREA

The approximate location will be given at the briefing and confirmed by VHF 30 minutes before the first Warning Signal.

8 – COURSE

8.1 The course will be as stated in the RS21SSIs.

9 – MARKS

Course mark 1 & 1a will be Orange inflatable buoys, 2s & 2p will be Black inflatable buoys. If Flag C is displayed at the gate replacement marks for 1 & 1a will be laid which will be Blue inflatable buoys.

The outer limit mark for the start and finish will be Orange.

10 - AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

22 - OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats will be identified as follows: Race Committee Signal Boat: RSrnYC Official Flag Judge Boats: White Flag with "J" on it Press Boat: RSrnYC Official Flag

23 - SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be registered and be identifiable as described in NOS 11.

28 – PRIZE GIVING

28.1 [NP] Prize giving will take place at the venue, when possible after the finish of the last race.

28.2 At least the following prizes will be awarded:

- the top three (3) boats in the event ranking
- the first Corinthian crew in the event ranking
- the first U23 crew in the event ranking.
