### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

- 1. GBR did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).
- 2. GBR did come to the hearing when the protest committee gave the decision.

### FACTS FOUND

- 1. Conditions 8 knots
- 2. ESP was low riding on starboard around the WW mark to be left to port.
- 3. GBR was sailing on starboard, clear astern of ESP and foiling.
- 4. When ESP entered the zone, GBR was clear astern.
- 5. GBR became inside overlapped of ESP within the zone
- 6. Contact occurred between ESP and GBR
- 7. Both boats capsized and became entangled.
- 8. GBR's foil damaged the port trampoline of ESP, causing a rip of 15 cm.
- 9. ESP continued sailing in the race
- 10. Neither boat took a penalty

### CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 18.2(b), 18.2(c)(2), 11, 14, 43.1(b), 62.2(b)

- 1. ESP to windward failed to keep clear of GBR to leeward and broke RRS 11.
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for ESP, the boat sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled to avoid contact with GBR when it was clear that GBR was not giving mark-room. ESP did not break RRS 14.
- GBR clear astern at the time ESP reached the zone was required by RRS 18.2(b) to give ESP mark-room. Once GBR became overlapped inside of ESP she did not give ESP room to sail her proper course while they remained overlapped and broke RRS 18.2(b) and 18.2(c)(2).
- 4. Since ESP broke RRS 11 while she was sailing within the mark-room to which she was entitled, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(b) for this breach.
- 5. ESP's place in F15 was made worse through her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
