- Ms Snell. Sandra is the observer
- Peter Wong representing Daydream
- Rob Partridge representing H3O
- Herman Wong is the witness, who was on Kiasu

FACTS FOUND

- H3O and Daydream were sailing downwind on port. Daydream was windward to H3O
- H3O luffed up to pass astern of Daydream
- H3O passed to windward of Daydream. Daydream luffed and H3O responded, once H30 had broken the overlap she bore away on to her proper course, sailing higher then DayDream,
- After approx 30 seconds later H3O jibed onto STB and Daydream kept sailing on Port. Daydream had room to keep clear of H3O,
- H3O and DayDream were on a collision course.
- Approx 16 seconds later after H3O sailing on starboard tack, H30 bore away to avoid contact with Davdream.
- DayDream continued to Port Tack.
- Regarding Rule 69. Different opinions, the witness could not confirm or deny any bad language.
