# **Organising Authority**

The Organising Authority is the Secunderabad Club (SSC) in association with the EMESA under the sanction of the Yachting Association of India (YAI)

## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024 (RRS).
- 1.2 In all rules governing this event, the notations;
  - 1.2.1 [DP] in a rule means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.
  - 1.2.2 [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the race committee or technical committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
  - 1.2.3 [NP] denotes a rule for which a breach of that rule shall not be grounds for protests by another boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
- 1.3 The Equipment Rules of Sailing and current class rules of the competing classes will apply.

- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.5 Appendix P will apply.

### 2. **ADVERTISING**

Competitor advertising will be restricted to World Sailing Regulation 20, Advertising Code.

### 3. **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The event will be sailed in the following classes for the purpose of ranking:-
  - (a) ILCA 4 (Boys & Girls). ILCA 4 shall be under 18 yrs (the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship). Ranking
  - (b) 420 (Open) (Boy/Boy, Girl/Girl, Mixed) (the age the competitor becomes in the year of the championship) Ranking
  - (c) 29er (Open) Ranking
  - (d) Optimist (Non Ranking)
  - (e) Optimist Green (Non Ranking)

#### Note:

- (i) Each sailor shall submit a signed/guardian consent form. For the duration of the championship each sailor shall be accompanied by a responsible adult who is named on the parental/guardian consent form.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending email to <a href="mailto:sailing@secunderabad.org">sailing@secunderabad.org</a> (entry fee may be paid at the time registration in Regatta Office).
- 3.3 The entry closing date is <u>05 Jul 2023</u>.
- 3.4 Late entries may be accepted till <u>09 Jul 2023</u> only at the discretion of the organisers/host club upon payment of an additional late entry fee of Rs. 5000/-.
- 3.5 Entry fees will not be refunded under any circumstance unless the entry is not accepted.

### 4. **FEES**

4.1 The entry fee will be as follows:-

All Classes entry - 9000 INR
Fee for registration of Coaches/Team Manager - 5000 INR

4.2 Female entries will be provided with 50% discount on Entry fees as per YAI Rules.

- 4.3 Entry fee includes lunch on racing days, attendance for select functions / ceremonies and certificates as applicable.
- 4.4 Entry fee does not include boarding and lodging. As per YAI guidelines the sailor and its affiliated club must be an active member of YAI and LCAI, 420 Assn, 29er Assn & Optimist Assn for taking part in competition.

#### 5 FORMAT

All classes will sail a single series of fleet races.

### 6 **SCHEDULE**

- 6.1 The Initial Competitors Briefing will be held at 1200hrs on 11 Jul 2022 at the Secunderabad Sailing Annex.
- 6.2 The Event Schedule is as follows:-

- 6.3 A total of 10 races per class are scheduled. Each class is scheduled to sail three (03) races per day, but may sail one additional race per day.
- 6.4 No warning signal will be made after 1400hr on 15 Jul 2022.
- 6.5 Any changes in NOR will be intimated to all clubs/associations and also will be posted on the official notice board.

### 7. **MEASUREMENTS**

- 7.1 All Boats will be inspected for the class rules compliance prior to racing as per schedule mentioned in the notice board.
- 7.2 Sail numbers to be strictly enforced as per Class Rule [DP][NP]
- 7.3 Equipment shall only be replaced/repaired with the written permission of the technical committee. Changes afloat may be approved after the race provided that either the Race Committee or the Technical Committee afloat is notified before the next race [DP] [NP]

#### 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

8.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after completion of registration on 11 Jul 2022 at Venue.

#### 9 **VENUE**

9.1 The venue for the event will be Hussain Sagar Lake, Tank Bund, Hyderabad, Telangana State.

#### 10. **COURSES**

10.1 The Courses will be Trapezoidal & Windward/Leeward or any other course as described in the sailing instructions.

### 11. **PENALTY SYSTEM**

11.1 Appendix 'P' will apply.

11.2 Decision of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5

### 12. **SCORING**

- 12.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will be used except as modified as follows: -
  - (a) Six (06) races are required to be completed to constitute a series for all categories.
  - (b) When six or fewer than six (06) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - (c) When seven (07) or more races but less than 10 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
  - (d) When ten (10) races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst score.

### 13. **SUPPORT BOATS [DP]**

- 13.1 All support boats shall stay outside the racing area (minimum 100 mtrs) from the time of the first warning signal for the first class to start till completion of racing for the day.
- 13.2 Support boats will be marked with their club insignia/white flag.

# 14. BERTHING [DP]

14.1 Boats will be kept in the assigned places while they are in the boat park.

## 15. RADIO COMMUNICATION [DP]

15.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

#### 16. **PRIZES**

- 16.1 The winner in each class will be awarded
- 16.2 Additional medals may be awarded by the OA
