PROCEDURAL MATTERS

CRO 217717 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. The wind was about 7-8 knots and the seas slight.
- 2. CRO 217717 and JPN 202611 rounded mark 4S with CRO 217717 astern of JPN 202611.
- 3. After rounding the mark there was contact between the bow of CRO 217717 and the stern of JPN 202611.
- 4. There was no damage.
- 5. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 63.3(b), RRS 12, RRS 14

- 1. CRO 217717 clear astern failed to keep clear of JPN 202611 clear ahead, and broke RRS 12 & RRS 14.
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for JPN 202611, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with CRO 217717 when it was clear that CRO 217717 was not keeping clear. JPN 202611 did not break RRS 14.

DECISION

CRO 217717 as a boat clear astern not keeping clear is disqualified.
