Pre-event reminders from the TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

@ All competitors:

- Bring your PFD for inspection during registration at the desk of the Technical Committee. PFDs must meet the requirements of General Class Rule 8.1.
- Make sure a righting line meeting the requirements of General Class Rule 8.2 is mounted on the boat.

@ All competitors:

- The use of electronic equipment on board is restricted by General Class Rule 16.3. It means the use of smartwatches, smartphones or any GPS device is not permitted while racing.

@ All competitors in classes with min. crew weight:

 For the weighing of competitors during registration bring any crew corrector weights if required to meet class minimum crew weight. As required by General Class Rule 17.4 corrector weights must be dry solid. Also see General Class Rule 17.5 and 17.6.

@ Hobie Dragoon & Hobie 16 SPI competitors:

- As required by the class rules and not least for safety reasons, please remember your bowsprit MUST have a blunt end cap fitted. If missing, you'll not be allowed to start until fixed.

@ Hobie 14 competitors:

- Have you for example sailed your boat in "Hobie 14 Turbo" configuration, please remember to replace your bridle wires with wires meeting the requirements of Hobie Cat 14 Class Rule 4.2, which specifies a minimum length of 154.62 cm pin to pin.

@ Hobie 14 & 16 competitors:

- If using the upgraded 6:1 downhaul system, the lower end of system shall be directly connected to the custom HCC supplied attachment near the mast-base and the upper end to the gooseneck via a shackle/pin (HC14 Rule 5.1 and HC16 Rule 6.1).
