#### **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

CAN 217312 did not withdraw the protest after the arbitration meeting.

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. The wind speed was about 10 knots and the sea state was choppy.
- 2. CAN 217312 and NED 221350 were approaching Mark 1 for the second time. The next leg of the course was a broad reach to Mark 2.
- 3. Both boats were overlapped on starboard tack with CAN 217312 1m to windward and a half boat length astern of NED 221350.
- 4. When both boats were bearing away to round the mark, contact occurred between the port quarter of NED 221350 and the windward side of the mark at deck level.
- 5. The closest distance between the two boats was a half boat length.
- 6. No boat took a penalty.
