- After completing the decision for Request 3, the protest committee determined that it may have made a significant error and reopened the hearing in accordance with RRS 66.3. That decision is in Decision #4

## **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. Heavy flood tide and 16-18 knots of breeze.
- 2. Maverick witnessed NeNe make contact with the weather mark on the first rounding.
- 3. During the transit to the offset mark NeNe had room and opportunity to take a penalty turn.
- 4. NeNe sailed beyond the offset mark and then completed a jibe and a tack.
