

Code of Conduct for Remote Hearings

All participants are expected to behave according to the principles of sportsmanship required by our sport. We thank you in advance for your Corinthian conduct.

In addition, while the hearing is in session:

- A party or witness shall not record, transmit or convey audio or video of the hearing. Individual screen capture of scenario images are permitted for your records only.
- A party or witness must ensure to the best of their ability, that they are not being observed or overheard by anyone who may have an interest in the proceedings.
- A party shall not communicate or share information with anyone outside of the hearing, by any means or technology.
- A party shall not communicate or share information with a witness, except when the witness is giving testimony before the Protest Committee/Jury.

A party or witness to the hearing that breaks an element of this Code, risks being found in breach of the principles of good sportsmanship and ethical behavior (see RRS 69.1(b)).
