FACTS FOUND

- 1. RC proceeded with wind measurements at least once every three minutes. The measurements were taken at the starting boat, at marks 1 and 2 and along the first reach.
- 2. Measurements never exceeded the limitation of 3 consecutive minutes of wind speeds above 23 knots. The maximum three minutes average was 21 knots. Gusts were up to 25 knots.
