## PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- Hearing No. 5 was heard together with Hearing No. 6 and Hearing No. 7 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since all hearings arose from the same incident.
- The RC was represented by race officer Miguel Amaral.

## FACTS FOUND

- RC proceeded with wind measurements at least once every three minutes. The measurements were taken at the starting boat, at marks 1 and 2 and along the first reach.
- Measurements never exceeded the limitation of 3 consecutive minutes of wind speeds above 23 knots. The maximum three minutes average was 21 knots. Gusts were up to 25 knots.
