PROCEDURAL MATTERS

- 1. ITA 9926 did not withdraw the protest after the arbitration meeting and neither boat accepted a Post-Race Penalty under RRS T1(a).
- 2. The panel of the International Jury was composed in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).

FACTS FOUND

- 1. ITA 9929 was on starboard tack at the starting line, perpendicular to wind and almost stationary.
- 2. SUI 1762 clear astern at a distance of 1m to ITA 9929 was sailing slightly faster.
- 3. Contact occurred between SUI 1762 bow and ITA 9929 rudder, causing a small crack on the rudder.
- 4. No boat took a penalty.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS N1.4(b), T1, 12, 14

- 1. SUI 1762 clear astern failed to keep clear of ITA 9929 clear ahead, and broke RRS 12.
- 2. SUI 1762 did not avoid contact when it was reasonably possible, and broke RRS 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for ITA 9929, the right-of-way boat to avoid contact with SUI 1762 when it was clear that SUI 1762 was not keeping clear. ITA 9929 did not break RRS 14.
