## 7. Description Of Incident

- Aurora checked into the check in vessel and attended the start area for the start of their class. There was a weather delay under AP and during that time period Aurora sustained damage to their boom vang and informed the RC via VHF that they were returning to the dock to effect repairs - not knowing how long the weather delay would last and that they intended to start
- The class was started while Aurora was not in the starting area and was not recorded as crossing the line by the RC.
- The RC removed the start line and proceeded back to shore.
- PRO John Osmond received a telephone call from Aurora while the RC vessel was in transit asking what they should do in relation to starting once they effected repairs.
- PRO informed them to take their time when crossing the start line and that it would be sorted out in Bermuda, but we could not guarantee them a result.
- Aurora started and raced the course, and was recorded by the RC as DNS.
