PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Antipodes was sailing on the SE coast of NCL in 18+ knots with passing sharp storms.
- 2. NCL MRCC advised RC that a PLB had been activated on Antipodes.
- 3. NCL MRCC and the RC made many unsuccessful attempts by VHF, satphone, and social media to contact Antipodes and boats nearby to investigate the activation.
- 4. Antipodes was receiving weak VHF transmissions that had heavy static and could not be understood.
- 5. After some hours NCL MRCC activated the SAR helo and directed Gendarmerie Maritime vessel Dunber to go Antipodes location.
- 6. When the SAR helo and Gendarmerie Maritime vessel Dunber arrived at Antipodes location they were able to establish VHF transmission and receive communications with Antipodes.
- 7. Antipodes submitted a detailed written description of the boat's watch keeping and navigation procedures.
- 8. Antipodes had a dedicated navigator continually monitoring their VHF radio scanning VHF channel 16 and 77.
- 9. MRCC provided written advice that the location where Antipodes was at the time of the incident and after was in an area of "...cone of non-propagation of VHF waves...".

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: SI 15.5

- 1. Antipodes maintained a listening watch on VHF channel on VHF 16 and 77 and did not breach SI15.5.
- 2. Antipodes not receiving VHF transmissions was caused or contributed to by the "...cone of non-propagation of VHF waves..." in the area they were sailing in.

1. No rule broken.
