PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

At the moment of the start, GBR 248 and CZE 89 were foiling on the starting line, CZE 89 overlapped to windward of GBR 248

CZE 89 lost control of her board and contact occurred between her sail and GBR 248

Both boards capsized. There was damage on the board of GBR 248.

No board took a penalty and both boards finished the race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

CZE 89 to windward did not keep clear of GBR 248 to leeward breaking rules 11 and 14

It was not reasonably possible for GBR 248 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14

The score of GBR 248 was made significantly worse in race 9 through no fault of her own by a capsize caused by the action of a board that was breaking a rule of part 2

DECISION

CZE 89 is DSQ in race 9

GBR 248 is given redress in race 9 and will be scored points equal to the average of her scores in the other course races sailed before the race in question rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other kiteboards.
