## PROCEDURAL MATTERS

LTU 7 was not present but sent a message and has completed a penalty report.

## FACTS FOUND

FRA 152 was sailing on starboard on a beat in 10th place. LTU 7 was sailing on port on collision course.

LTU 7 lost control of her board and contact occurred between FRA 152 and LTU 7.

FRA 152 capsized but there was no damage or injury.

LTU 7 took a 360 turn penalty promptly.

FRA 152 recovered and finished the race in 30th place.

## CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

LTU 7 on port did not keep clear of FRA 152 on starboard, breaking rules  $10\ \text{and}\ 14$ 

LTU 7 took the appropriate penalty for her breach

It was not reasonably possible for FRA 152 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14

The score of FRA 152 was made significantly worse in race 9 through no fault of her own by a capsize caused by the action of a board that was breaking a rule of part 2

No further penalty to LTU 7

FRA 152 is given redress in race 9 and will be scored in 10th place. This shall not change the score of the other boards.
