## PROCEDURAL MATTERS

ISR 1 retired and was not present in the hearing

## FACTS FOUND

FRA 7 and ISR 1 were sailing on the beat, FRA 7 on starboard around 6th place and ISR 1 on port on collision course.

ISR 1 held her course and FRA 7 luffed sharply and crash tacked.

Contact occurred between the bow of ISR 1 and the stern of FRA 7.

FRA 7 capsized, recovered in about 20th place and finished the race in 18th place.

There was a surface scratch on the sail of FRA 7

ISR 1 retired from race 2

## CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

ISR 1 on port did not keep clear of FRA 7 breaking rules 10 and 14

It was not reasonably possible for FRA 7 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break rule 14

The score of FRA 7 was made significantly worse in race 2 through no fault of her own by a capsize caused by the action of a board that was breaking a rule of part 2

## DECISION

**Date & Time:** 2020-10-20 20:24 CEST

No further penalty to ISR 1

FRA 7 is given redress in race 2 and will be scored points equal to the average of her scores in the other course races of the qualifying series rounded to the nearest tenth of a point (0.05 to be rounded upward). This shall not change the score of the other boards.
