PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Following the fourth general recall to the start of race 1, GBR 216209 sailed past the R/C Signal Boat and asked in a loud, sarcastic tone, "If you squared the line we might have a race before sunset."
- 2. The volunteer members on the R/C Signal Boat agreed that they had been offended by the boat's actions.
- 3. During the hearing GBR 216209 expressed regret that his statement had been taken as offensive. He admitted that "we might have a race before sunset" was meant as sarcasm and apologized for making it. He said he spoke in a loud voice hoping that he could be heard over the ambient noise.
- 4. The wind was 6 knots.
