PROCEDURAL MATTERS

1. Heard with No. 3 same incident.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. +/-20 kt windspeed, good visibility.
- 2. Scimitar J (SJ) tacked onto starboard.
- 3. Scarlett (S) had just completed a tack onto port when SJ tacked which put the boats on a converging course.
- 4. Both boats observed each other at approx. 80-100 m.
- 5. SJ hailed and signaled S a minimum of three times to keep clear.
- 6. At approx. 3-5 BL separation S changed course to starboard attempting to keep clear of SJ.
- 7. There was contact resulting in serious damage to both boats.
- 8. Both boats retired from the race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

- Rules: 10,13, 14,15, 43.1(c), 44.1(b), definition Room, Keep Clear, Case 17
- 1. SJ had completed their tack, RRS 13, Case 17.
- 2. SJ gave S room to keep clear, RRS 15, definition of Room and Keep Clear.
- 3. S on port tack did not keep clear of SJ on starboard tack, RRS 10, and definition of Keep Clear.
- 4. It was reasonably possible for S to avoid contact with SJ, RRS 14.

5. When SJ became aware that S was not keeping clear maintaining her course was the most appropriate action which they took, RRS 14.

- 6. SJ is not exonerated for breaking RRS 14 as there was damage and injury, RRS 43.1(c).
- 7. Both boats retired, RRS 44.1(b).

DECISION

1. As both boats retired no further penalty is applied.
