USA 217353 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

# **FACTS FOUND**

- 1. The wind speed was 12 knots and the sea state was choppy.
- 2. USA 187738 was sailing on starboard fetching the windward mark.
- 3. USA 217353 was sailing on a port tack collision course with USA 187738.
- 4. USA 187738 hailed "starboard" several times but USA 217353 kept her course and speed.
- 5. At five boat lengths from the mark and ½ m from USA 217353, USA 187738 bore away 40 degrees and passed astern of USA 217353.
- 6. If USA 187738 held her course, her bow would have made contact with the starboard quarter of USA 217353.
- 7. There was no contact and no damage.
- 8. No boat took a penalty.

1. USA 217353 on port failed to keep clear of USA 187738 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
