OFFSHORE AND THE 2021 PALMAVELA

The 17th edition of the PalmaVela, the Mediterranean's popular international regatta, has published the Notice of Race. It is available on the official website www.palmavela.com, where those who are interested can now register their entries.

Programme

New this year will be an offshore race which will complement the regular programme for PalmaVela. So La Larga - the PalmaVela Offshore Race will be held October 22 to 26. The first two days are reserved for processing registrations and carrying out measurement controls, while the start of the offshore race will take place on Sunday, October 24, at 12:00 hours local time.

PalmaVela's inshore races will be held from October 27 to 31, with different race areas and courses on different days for the registered classes.

Boats

<u>Boats invited to compete in the Offshore Race of PalmaVela:</u> ORC / ORC Club and IRC boats with a length greater than 9.14 m. There will be two different courses depending on the length and the number of participants.

Boats invited to PalmaVela: Maxi Yachts, Wally, IRC, ORC, Classics, One design and Disabled Sailing.

Courses

<u>Offshore Race</u>: will be sailed around the islands of the Balearic archipelago. Small boats will race a 165 nm course and 225 nm for bigger boats.

<u>PalmaVela</u>: all the races will be held on the bay of Palma. Each class will have the usual PalmaVela race programme, which is described below:

Big boats and IRC: 4 days of W / L and coastal courses. ORC: 3 days of W / L and coastal courses. Classics: 3 days of coastal courses. Monotypes: 3 days of W / L courses. Disable sailing: 2 days of W / L courses.

Registration for both events will be made online on the website www.palmavela.com

PalmaVela offers discounts for early payment (see point 6 of the NR).





The registration price includes both events both the Offshore and the PalmaVela. The person responsible for the registration must mark the intention to do one or both regattas.

It is mandatory to send the proof of payment and the valid certificate to give the registration as completed.

The prize giving ceremony for both events will be held on Sunday, October 31, on the terraces of the RCNP. Prizes will be awarded to the winners of each class, both of the Offshore regatta and the 2021 PalmaVela.

The Offshore and PalmaVela trophies will be a work of art by an artist, continuing with the PalmaVela Awards Collection, which is now in its 7th edition.

Organizers

The Offshore and the 2021 PalmaVela are organized by the Real Club Náutico de Palma and have the institutional support of the Balearic Government, the Palma City Council, the Balearic Port Authority, the Maritime Captaincy, the Club Nàutic S'Arenal, the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation and the Balearic Sailing Federation.

2021 PalmaVela is an event supported by the IMA (International Maxi Association) and is part of its Mediterranean Inshore Challenge circuit. PalmaVela is also one of the three events that make up the Mediterranean Sailing Circuit of ORC boats, in addition





to the Spanish Cup for the Dragon class.
