7. Description Of Incident

Sail no. 17656 was coming across on starboard tack upwind in race no. 1 on a collision course with sail number 2020. 17655 hailed starboard, 2020 ignored it, forcing 17656 to shoot head to wind to avoid a very dangerous collision. 17656 had to round up to avoid a collision, causing 1775 to also round up to avoid a collision too.

17656 and 1775 both hailed protest to 2020 , no action was taken by 2020. Protest flag was displayed also. This was dangerous and clearly in breach of the port and starboard rule. If 17656 and 1775 had not altered course there would have been serious damage to all boats.
