7. Description Of Incident

The scoring for Wed series July 6 Race #8 is wrong. Simply Red was listed as OCS, however our actual placing was ~6. Too much time has passed to enable accurate recollection. However one thing for sure, and a fact that can be used to cross check the accuracy of a revision to SRed's score, is that we were awarded beer that evening, we assume for either a 2nd or 3rd place for the night.

I sent Sailing Dir Webb an email on July 13 requesting that he correct the scoring; followed up with a vc msg a week later - no response. Called SDir Webb on or about Aug 3, during which conversation he stated he had been remiss in getting back to me, acknowledged the scoring was in error, indicated he has hard copy of the actual race finishes and would correct the scoring. As of 125pm today, the scoring still shows OCS.

I regret having to go the "formal route" to precipitate corrective action. However allowing scoring errors to remain for 5+ weeks is inappropriate, and causes extra work for Fleet scorekeeper who relies on the accuracy of the Royal Van posted results.

Unrelated to the above but possibly indicative of a breakdown in the recording of One Design race finishes is the M242 scoring for last nite (Wed Aug 10): it is all scrambled.
