PROCEDURAL MATTERS

Hearing No.1 was heard together with Hearing No.2 in accordance with RRS 63.2 since both hearings arose from the same incident.

FACTS FOUND

- 1. In race 5, the wind was about 7 knots and the sea flat.
- 2. Boat 9, windward and boat 5 leeward and slightly ahead were both on port tack in the zone of Mark1.
- 3. Boat 1 on starboard was fetching the mark and converging on a collision course with boat 5.
- 4. When boat 5 was about a boat length from boat 1, boat 5 tacked without first hailing for room from boat 9.
- 5. Immediately after completing her tack on starboard, 5 made contact with 9.
- 6. Both boats were entangled but there was no damage or injury.
- 7. Boat 5 rounded mark 1 and carried out 2 penalty turns.
- 8. Both boats finished the race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: 10,14,15,20.1(a),43.1(a)

- 1. Boat 9 on port failed to keep clear of boat 5 on starboard, and broke RRS 10 and RRS14 for not avoiding contact.
- 2. When acquiring right of way through her own actions, boat 5 failed to initially give boat 9 room to keep clear, and broke RRS 15
- 3. Boat 5 also broke rule 14 for not avoiding contact.
- 4. Boat 5 tacked without hailing for room from boat 9, an obligation under rule 20 when approaching an obstruction (boat 1).
- 5. Boat 5 carried out 2 penalty turns but was not done as soon as possible after the incident as required by RRS44.2 and is therefore too late.
- 6. Since boat 9 was compelled to break RRS10 and 14 as a consequence of boat 5 breaking RRS 15, she is exonerated under RRS 43.1(a) for this breach.

DECISION

Boat 5 is DSQ in race 5
