

Base Discretionary Penalties for Competitors

Penalties are divided into 4 bands with the mid point being the normal base penalty:

- (a) Band 1 0 10% (mid point 5%)
- (b) Band 2 10 30% (mid point 20%)
- (c) Band 3 30 70% (mid point 50%)
- (d) Band 4 DSQ / DNE (starting point DSQ)

Generally the base penalty will be the mid-point of the band.

Base Discretionary Penalties for Support Persons & Boats

Discretionary Penalties to a Support Persons

Penalties are divided into 5 levels as follows:

Level 1: Warning

Level 2: Exclude the person from going afloat for one race or more

Level 3: Exclude the person from going afloat for one day or more

Level 4: Exclude the person from the venue for one day or more

<u>Level 5:</u> Exclude the person from the venue for the rest of the event and/or take other action within the protest committee's jurisdiction as provided by the rules, including charging the support person with misconduct under RRS 69.

Support boats

Discretionary Penalties to a Boat

The protest committee may also penalize a boat that is a party to a hearing under RRS 60.3(d) or 69 for the breach of a rule by a support person by changing the boat's score in a single race, up to and including DSQ. In determining the penalty, the protest committee will be guided by this document.

Penalties are divided into 4 bands with the mid-point being the normal base penalty:

(a) Band 1 – 0 - 10% (mid-point 5%)

(b) Band 2 – 10 - 30% (mid-point 20%)

(c) Band 3 – 30 - 70% (mid-point 50%)

(d) Band 4 – DSQ
