- Amendment to NOR 4. To add the following:  
IRC rule 8.6 to be deleted. Boats shall declare which TTC rating they would be using (with or without spinnaker) latest by 1700hr on the 23 July 2022.
- Amendment to SI 6.1. to add the following:  
On 24 July, the first possible Warning Signal is at 0755hr. There will be an interval of at least 5 minutes before the Warning Signal for the next Class. The order of starting will be as follows:  
First start: IRC Class  
Followed by: SB20 Class  
Followed by: PY Class  
Followed by: Multihulls Class  
Followed by: Cutter Class
- Amendment to SI 7. To replace with the following:

4. Amendment to SI 8.1. To delete and replace with the following:
- 8.1 Addendum 1 (Course Area Book) shows the location of the racing areas.
- Addendum 1(a) – IRC Class Passage Race course
  - Addendum 1(b) – Multihull, PY & SB20 Class Passage Race course
  - Addendum 1(c) – Cutter Class Passage Race course
5. Amendment to SI 9.2. To delete 'Multihull' in the paragraph.
6. Amendment to SI 9.2.1. To delete '1500hr' and replace with '1300hr'.
7. Amendment to SI 10.1. To replace with the following:
- 10.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starting mark at the starboard end (CSC Jetty) and the course side of the port-end starting mark (CSC1 ODM), including the extension of the starting line beyond the port-end starting mark but no further than a safety boat displaying an orange flag.
8. Amendment to SI 13. To replace SI 13.1 & SI 13.3 and add SI 13.5 with the following:

13.1 The Race Time Limits are as follows:

CLASS/DIVISION	TARGET TIME	TIME LIMIT (RRS35)	FINISHING TIME LIMIT
IRC	8hr	1600hr	See SI 13.3
Multihull / PY	6hr	1600hr	See SI 13.3
SB20	6hr	1600hr	See SI 13.3
Cutter	5hr	1400hr	30 mins

13.3 For IRC, Multihull, PY & SB20 classes, the finishing time limit is 90 minutes after the first boat in its class sails the course and finishes or 1600hr, whichever is later.

13.5 Boats shall finish no later than the Finishing Time Limit. Boats failing to finish by the Finishing Time Limit, and not subsequently retiring, penalised or given redress, will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35 and A5.1.
