## **PROCEDURAL MATTERS**

#### **FACTS FOUND**

A few seconds before the start, both riders 4 and 16 were sailing on starboard tack with 4 clear ahead of 16.

Rider 16 established a leeward overlap.

While both boards were overlapped the lines of rider 16 touched rider 4's lines.

Both riders remained overlapped for approximately 2 seconds.

When rider 16 breaks the overlap becoming clear ahead of rider 4, rider 4's canopy went through the lines of rider 16 and tangled.

Both riders were scored DNS.

No rider took a penalty.

# **CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY**

**Rules:** 11, 14, 15, 43.1(a), 62.1(b)

When rider 16 acquired the right of way, he was required to initially give rider 4 room to keep clear. Rider 16 failed to give rider 4 room to keep clear as required by RRS 15.

By not avoiding contact, rider 16 also broke RRS 14. For rider 4 it was not reasonably possible to avoid contact and therefore did not break RRS 14.

Rider 4 to windward of rider 16 failed to keep clear of him, breaking RRS 11; but it is exonerated according to RRS 43.1(a).

Neither rider met the requirements of RRS 62.1(b), and therefore are not entitled to redress.

Rider 16 is to be scored DSQ in race 12.
