PROCEDURAL MATTERS

FACTS FOUND

- 1. Race 4, flat water, 7-8 knots.
- 2. Approaching the windward mark, outside of the zone.
- 3. 37 port, 52 starboard.
- 4. 37 tacked on starboard.
- 5. 37 was 5-10 meters ahead of 52.
- 6. 52 was sailing 50% faster than 34.
- 7. 52 bore away to pass to leeward of 34.
- 8. 37 was still moving his kite down.
- 9. 52 became overlapped to leeward and immediately a contact occurred between 37's kite and 52's string.
- 10. 52's kite was immediately flapping and fell in the water.
- 11. No injury, no penalty turn was taken.
- 12. A knot was created in 37's lines.
- 13. 37 was not able to launch his kite again.
- 14. 37 did not finish the race.

CONCLUSIONS AND RULES THAT APPLY

Rules: RRS 14, 15, F2.16.1, F4.44.1(b), 62.1

- 1. 37 after acquiring right of way did not initially give room to 52 to keep clear, breaking RRS 15.
- 37 right of way, changed the position of her kite without giving room to 52 to keep clear, breaking RRS F2.16.1 and 14.
- 3. It was not reasonably possible for 52 to avoid the contact, therefore she did not break RRS 14.
- 4. By retiring, 37 took the appropriate penalty under F4.44.1(b).
- 5. The score of 37 in race 4 was made worse through her own fault. Therefore, the requirements for redress in RRS 62.1 are not met.
